GUNDERLOCH NACKENHEIMER ROTHENBERG RIESLING GROSSES GEWÄCHS 2019

18 Points - Drink 2022 - 2030

"The Rothenberg's fragrance impresses primarily with fresh herbal and mineral aromas, fruit represented by a gentle notion of apricot. The taste is defined by a rich salty minerality, cool herbal notes and a very delicate expression of peach and grapefruit. A firm structure indicates great ageing potential" - Michael Schmidt



GUNDERLOCH NIERSTEINER HIPPING RIESLING GROSSES GEWÄCHS 2019 18 Points - Drink 2022 – 2030

"Still a little shy on the nose, but showing encouraging signs of herbal freshness, supported by the merest notion of caramel. The palate rocks with flinty and salty minerality, brazen acidity, phenolic herbaceousness and not an ounce of sweetness in sight. Truly trocken, not for the squeamish." - Michael Schmidt



GUNDERLOCH, NIERSTEINER PETTENTHAL RIESLING GROSSES GEWÄCHS 2019 18.5 Points - Drink 2022 – 2030

"Gentle notes of local vineyard fruit add an appealing touch to the animating expression of fresh and green-vegetal aromas. A mere hint of caramel can be interpreted as the result of vinification in wooden barrels. On the palate the Pettenthal bristles with energy, instigated by reverberating acidity and a solid block of salty minerality. The alcohol content may be modest, but the extract is high." - Michael Schmidt





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
