DEUTSCHLAND WEIN TOUR 2025 - YVES BECK

Robert Weil Rheingau Riesling Trocken 2024 – 93 Points

What energy and vitality in the bouquet of this Riesling! The freshness of the vintage is noticeable from the very first sip, as is its maturity. A benchmark wine that underscores the greatness of the grape variety and the winery from the very beginning! This Riesling is straightforward, harmonious, lively, and leaves you wanting more. A magnificent wine. 2026-2049

Robert Weil Kiedricher Riesling Trocken 2024 – 94 Points

One-third of a 2400-liter oak barrel was used for the maturation of this Kiedrich, which is partly made from young vines from the top vineyard sites. The bouquet is precise and clearly defined, with hints of stone fruit, anise, and tobacco leaves. Complexity is omnipresent on both the nose and palate. The wine possesses dimension, finesse, and precision. Its distinctive character complements the existing power, creating an inspiring balance. 2026-2054

Robert Weil Kiedricher Klosterberg Riesling Trocken EL 2024 – 95 Points

The soils of the Klosterberg vineyard are rich in iron, with a slightly reddish hue. The bouquet unfolds gradually, discreetly yet effectively in its depth and complexity. Nothing dominates; everything is harmonious and precise. The straightforwardness of the bouquet continues beautifully on the palate. The wine is delicate yet possesses a certain breadth. The acidity provides the wine's energy, while subtle bitter notes contribute power and length. A wine of great finesse, distinguished by its long finish. 2028-2054

Robert Weil Kiedricher Turmberg Riesling Trocken EL 2024 – 94 Points

The minerality in the bouquet clearly demonstrates what this term actually means, or rather, what is meant by it! In this case, it's obvious ;-) The mineral aspect is complemented by notes of citrus fruits and dried herbs. The opening is saline, and the wine combines temperament with power. It is elegant, juicy, and long-lasting. Drink now until 2050.

Robert Weil Monte Nostrum Riesling Trocken 2024 – 98 Points

This wine comes from the highest-altitude parcels of the estate. Twenty-year-old vines. The bouquet impresses with its diversity, featuring notes of yellow fruits, anise, and licorice. The wine is slightly saline on the palate and is characterized by its richness and power, ultimately resulting in harmony. It tends towards extremes without falling into any particular category. A tightrope walker, it moves forward with composure, captivating with its ability to combine concentration, freshness, and vibrancy. 2027-2054

Robert Weil Kiedricher Gräfenberg Riesling Trocken GG 2024 – 99 Points

The subtle olfactory nuances contrast with the profound and captivating bouquet, which also displays hints of maturity. A fusion of citrus and yellow fruit notes. Like the bouquet, the palate is multifaceted, uniting energy, temperament, and finesse. The discreet salinity on the attack goes hand in hand with the exhilarating power. These two components propel the wine on its journey to depth and strength. A Gräfenberg of rare elegance, underscoring just how magnificent 2024 can be! 2028-2054

Robert Weil Kiedricher Gräfenberg Riesling Trocken GG 2023 – 97 Points

This precise and perfectly defined Gräfenberg reveals minerality and subtle fruity nuances. On the palate, it is characterized by its density and finesse. While full-bodied, it is also muscular and linear. A powerful and elegant wine, ideally supported by its phenolic structure and acidity. 2028-2063
